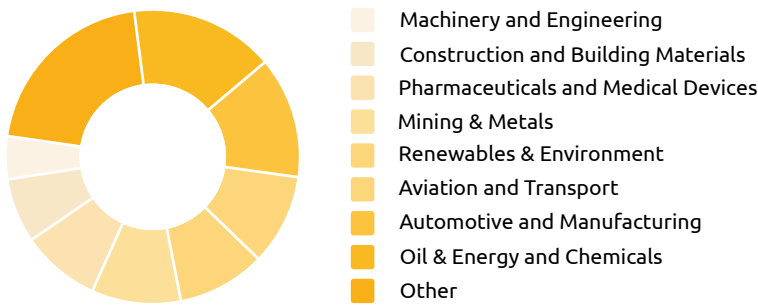

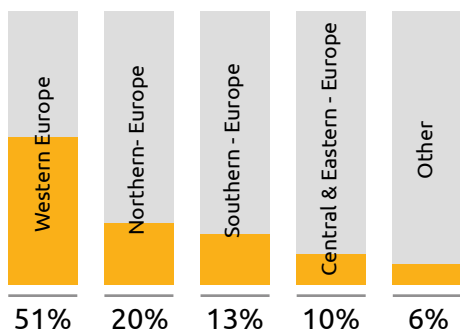

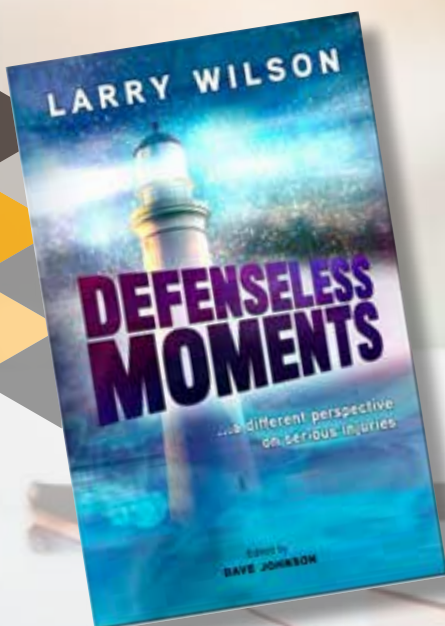

09:00 Defenseless Moments: A Different Perspective On Serious Injuries And Fatalities

Recordable injuries have come down over the last 10 years but serious injuries and fatalities have not—why? One potential explanation is that the standard model or matrix for risk assessment (probability of severity vs. probability of occurrence) didn't include human factors: The component or piece of metal doesn't care if it fails or breaks, but we do. In this session, participants will learn what really causes the majority of serious injuries and fatalities. It is not intuitive. More importantly, they will also learn four critical error reduction techniques that have been proven to significantly reduce serious injuries with over 4,000,000 employees in 66 countries, 24/7.
