#### **UK v World**

1.7-million – work related illness

**776,000** – work-related stress, depression and anxiety

138 – work-related deaths

**604,000** – injured at work

**61,663** - RIDDORS

**33.7 –million** lost working days

£21.6- billion (22/23)

**c.160-million** –non-fatal occupational diseases

Nearly 3-million – work-related deaths (2.6-million occupational diseases) (330,000 from accidents)

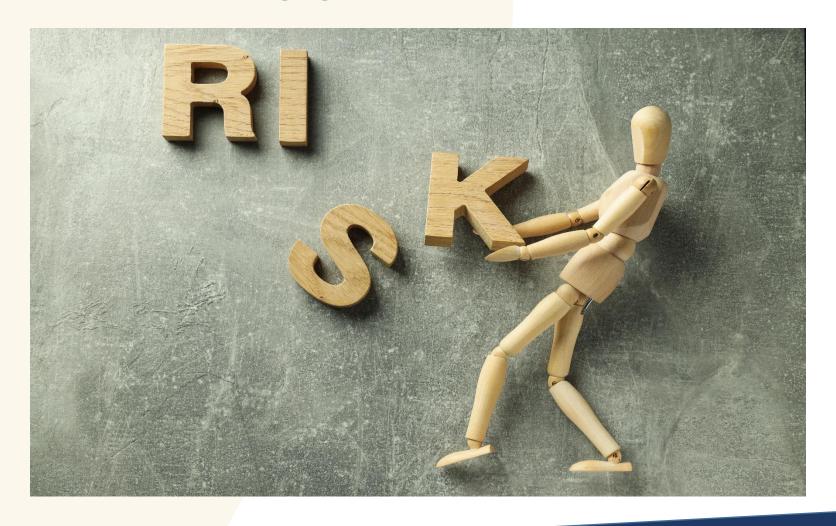
**c.270-million** – non-fatal occupational injuries

c.4% of global GDP (global cost)

Estimated global monetary cost: US \$2.8 trillion per yr.

**Cost to UK Employers** – poor employee mental health **£51 billion per year** (Deloitte)

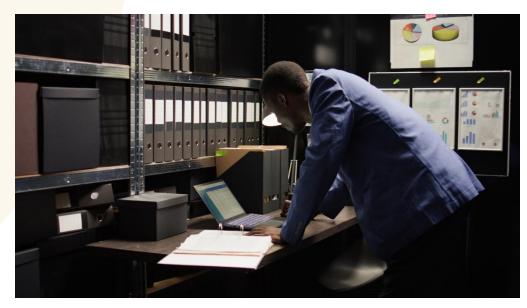
Presentism - £24 billion annually
